



Level 2 in Women's Hairdressing and Men's Barbering

Dates: 18/09/2024

Locations: Lisson Grove Centre

This Level 2 Diploma will teach you the underpinning principles and practical skills required to become a stylist of women's hair and men's barbering. Different cutting, colouring and styling techniques will be developed using live models as well as theory classes about Health and safety, salon reception, client consultation skills and developing your own designs.

Entry Requirements

This is a Level 2 course. You should have a Level 1 in women's hairdressing or equivalent experience. This course requires an interview for acceptance so any queries you have can be addressed. You should also have level 1 English and math's and basic IT skills.

What topics does the course cover?

In this course you will cover client consultation, shampoo and conditioning, different cutting techniques for men and women's hair, styling and dressing techniques, colouring and perming, style and finish of African hair types, plaiting and twisting hair, health and safety and salon practices within the industry.

How will I be taught and assessed?

The course will be taught through a blend of practical work, demonstrations and theory classes delivered on site in class and on line. Learners will work on live models and training heads. You will sit exams to assess your theory knowledge and build a portfolio of evidence which will be assessed in order to demonstrate your competence and gain your qualification. You will need access to reliable internet and the use of a PC or laptop in order to attend the online sessions.

Are there any other costs or equipment I need to get?

Learners are expected to provide their own kit of brushes, combs and scissors if not eligible for Bursary support. Your tutor can advise you on this in week 1 about the kit you will need to purchase.

By the end of the course what should I be able to do?

You will have professional skills which include client consultation, shampoo and conditioning, different cutting techniques, styling and dressing techniques, colouring and perming, Health and safety, and salon practices within the industry.

What are the progression opportunities following this course?

Upon successful completion of this course you can go directly into employment in the hairdressing industry as a junior stylist or progress onto the Level 3 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing.
