Through demonstrations, discussions, workshop practice, one to one instruction and guidance.

Calico and pattern cutting materials will be provided. Please bring a notebook, pen and pencil.

## By the end of the course what should I be able to do?

Make a custom corset pattern you can reuse. Increase your skills to make future designs.
