



# Evening Ceramics

This evening ceramics course introduces the basic handbuilding and wheel throwing techniques through practical demonstration and guidance. Learners will also gain skills in glazing.

## Entry Requirements

Suitable for all levels, no prior knowledge of ceramics is required to attend this course. The course is ideal for beginners or those who have some basic understanding of ceramic processes and would like to work more independently.

## What topics does the course cover?

Hand building techniques such as coiling, slab-building and press-moulding. Wheel-throwing techniques such as centering, cylinders and bowls. Learners will also be guided through some surface decoration and glazing techniques.

## How will I be taught and assessed?

Learners will receive feedback on progress from the tutor on a regular basis. At the end of the course learners will assess their individual progress and progression with the tutor.

## Are there any other costs or equipment I need to get?

All equipment, decoration and glaze materials are included, we do make a small charge (priced per kilo) for the clay used before the first firing only.

## By the end of the course what should I be able to do?

By the end of the course learners will be able to independently use basic hand building / throwing techniques and enhance completed work with surface decoration and/or glazing.

## **What are the progression opportunities following this course?**

This course will enable learners to progress on to other evening class courses or higher level courses which will be discussed at the end of the course with the tutor.
